



Ingleton village has a history that stretches back to the Iron Age, indeed reach the summit of Ingleborough and you might be able to identify the remains of at least six ancient hut circles possibly dating back to pre-Roman times. The church of St Mary's has one of Ingleton's oldest treasures, an 800 year old Norman font.

There are hundreds of caves and potholes to be explored. Tuition and guides for most outdoor activities can be arranged locally.

Ingleton has an award winning open air swimming pool, children's playground and a riverside picnic area.

Ramblers, school parties and study groups will find plenty to interest them, including fell walking, potholing, geological and historical studies.

Our location is 10 miles from Settle, 5 miles from Kirkby Lonsdale, 17 miles from Hawes and only ½ mile to the nearest pub. We are situated approximately 1 mile from the village centre and ½ mile from the main A65 Settle to Kendal road
